

## **RESOLUTION**

### **RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND CONFIRMING AN ASSESSMENT ROLL, YEAR 2022-2023, FOR THE UPTOWN 23RD BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY IMPROVEMENT AND SPECIAL SERVICES ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NUMBER ELEVEN (11), FOR PROPERTIES WITH COMMERCIAL FRONTAGE ON AND AROUND NW 23RD STREET BETWEEN I-235 AND SHARTEL AVENUE.**

**WHEREAS**, certain citizens and commercial property owners along a portion of NW 23<sup>rd</sup> Street petitioned The City of Oklahoma City pursuant to the Oklahoma Improvement District Act, 11 Okla. Stat. § 39-101, *et seq.*, to create an improvement and special services assessment district, Uptown 23rd Business Improvement District, City of Oklahoma City Improvement and Special Assessment District Number Eleven (11); and

**WHEREAS**, on September 24, 2019, the Council approved a Resolution creating the Uptown BID, City of Oklahoma City Improvement and Special Services Assessment District Number Eleven (11) (“Uptown BID”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Uptown BID provides professional services such as management and marketing, beautification and security for the district and businesses within the district; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 23, 2021, Council approved a Resolution adopting and confirming the assessment roll for the third year of ten years of the Uptown BID; and

**WHEREAS**, concurrently with the adoption of the Resolution confirming the annual assessment roll, the City Council approved an Ordinance adopting and setting the assessment roll, establishing the time and terms of payment of the assessments, and provided for the filing of liens with the County Clerk against each parcel for which the assessment was not paid; and

**WHEREAS**, 11 Okla. Stat. § 39-101 *et seq.*, which governs special assessment districts, requires an annual update of the assessment roll and a public hearing on the assessment roll prior to adopting and finally setting the assessment roll; and

**WHEREAS**, the Uptown BID has requested a continuation of the Improvement District for the fourth year of its 10-year term; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council determines it is desirable to continue to provide or cause to be provided the improvements and services authorized for the Uptown BID; and

**WHEREAS**, City staff has prepared an assessment roll, attached hereto as Exhibit “A”, listing the properties to be assessed, the known identity of property owners as reflected in the property records of Oklahoma County, and the amount of assessment against each tract or parcel of land to be assessed in the Uptown BID for Year 2022-2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the assessment roll against each tract or parcel of land to be assessed has been filed in the Office of the City Clerk, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the City Council of The City of Oklahoma City does hereby adopt and confirm the assessment roll for the Uptown 23rd Business Improvement District, City of Oklahoma City Improvement and Special Services Assessment District Number Eleven (11) for Year 2022-2023, that is incorporated herein by specific reference.
