

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION RECOMMENDING THE GOODHOLM HOUSE BE DELISTED FROM THE NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES

WHEREAS, the Goodholm House (NRIS #83002099) was listed in the National Record of Historic Places on March 30, 1983, for its architectural significance; and

WHEREAS, the Goodholm House is no longer located within the city limits of the City of Oklahoma City as it was relocated to 10735 Northeast 23rd Street, Choctaw, Oklahoma in 2008 and was subsequently demolished in September 2021; and

WHEREAS, 36 CFR §60.15, states grounds for removing properties from the National Register include (1) The property has ceased to meet the criteria for listing in the National Register because the qualities which caused it to be originally listed have been lost or destroyed, or such qualities were lost subsequent to nomination and prior to listing; and

WHEREAS, the Goodholm House no longer meets the criteria for listing in the National Register of Historic Places; and

WHEREAS, this action is consistent with the provisions of Chapter 59, Section 3300.2 of the Oklahoma City Municipal Code, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE OKLAHOMA CITY HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION, THAT:

The proposal to delist the Goodholm House, previously located in Oklahoma City, and now no longer extant, from the National Register of Historic Places (NRIS #83002099) is hereby recommended for approval to the Mayor and City Council, the Oklahoma Historic Preservation Review Committee, the State Historic Preservation Officer, and the Keeper of the National Register.
