
On 03/01/2023, Planning Department staff received your request for a Historic Preservation Certificate of Appropriateness for the property located at **110 NW 10th Street**.

light function to be restored

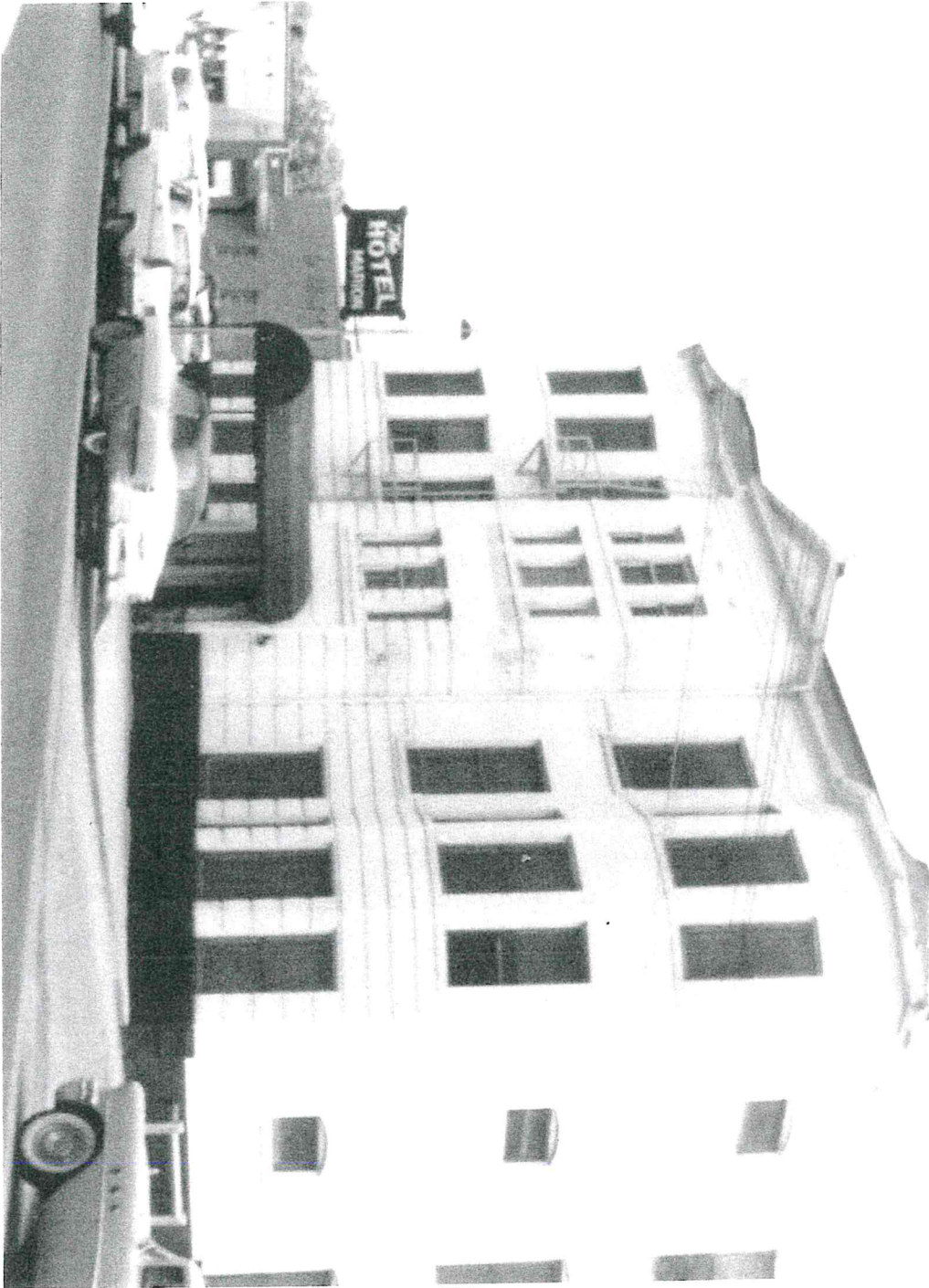
