To the HP Commissioners:

I have already written in support of the new sidewalk on Shartel. This email is to let you know what a huge benefit that the City is bestowing on our historic neighborhood.

What we currently use as a walking path along Shartel is a bike lane that bicyclist rarely use because of some of the road conditions.

I walk on Shartel from 44th street to 37th street at least once a day every day with a walking group and have seen a deterioration in the street over the years – in particular along the curb where the asphalt has failed. One of our walking group sprained her ankle in one of the deteriorate gutter holes along the edge of Shartel.

Giving all the citizens of Oklahoma City a safe place to walk is something that the City of Oklahoma City has been striving for. The sidewalk project presented to the HP commission will start to address some of the hazards to walking along that boulevard. I have included a few photo examples of the Shartel deterioration below:



The City project will remove the curbs, extend a sidewalk out 5' and provide new curbs along the length of Shartel from 38th to 43rd Street, creating a safe place for everyone from young children to the elderly to walk.

Please help provide this for the Citizens of Crown Heights and all of Oklahoma City.
