

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CHANGE IN THE COST ESTIMATE FOR COMPUTERS, SOFTWARE, RELATED SUPPLIES, AND SERVICES, INLAND ASSOCIATES, INC. (R24-C221020), PACIFIC EAST INDUSTRIES (R24-C221021), STAPLES TECHNOLOGY SOLUTIONS (R24-C221022) AND TURN-KEY MOBILE, INC. (R24-C221023), ESTIMATED COST INCREASE OF \$500,000 TO A TOTAL OF \$1,500,000, FOR THE PERIOD ENDING MAY 18, 2024.

WHEREAS, these pricing agreements were renewed on May 9, 2023 (Item No. IX.B) for the period ending May 18, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the original annual estimated amount of \$1,000,000 is not sufficient to replace outdated laptops and docking stations currently in use in the Police and Fire fleet; and

WHEREAS, these outdated computers are end of life and no longer under warranty; and

WHEREAS, the Information Technology Department has a funded CIP project for the replacement of these laptops and docking stations; and

WHEREAS, the equipment replaced will be surplus through on-line auction, following the City of Oklahoma City's prescribed surplus procedures; and

WHEREAS, revenue resulting from the sale of these items will be deposited to its original funding source.

WHEREAS, staff requests Council authorize a change in the cost estimate for computers, software, related supplies, and services, Inland Associates, Inc. (R24-C221020), Pacific East Industries (R24-C221021), Staples Technology Solutions (R24-C221022) and Turn-Key Mobile, Inc. (R24-C221023), estimated cost increase of \$500,000 to a total of \$1,500,000, for the period ending May 18, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of The City of Oklahoma City that they do hereby authorize a change in the cost estimate for computers, software, related supplies, and services, Inland Associates, Inc. (R24-C221020), Pacific East Industries (R24-C221021), Staples Technology Solutions (R24-C221022) and Turn-Key Mobile, Inc. (R24-C221023), estimated cost increase of \$500,000 to a total of \$1,500,000, for the period ending May 18, 2024.
