RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL COUNSELOR TO CONFESS JUDGMENT WITHOUT ADMITTING LIABILITY IN THE MATTER OF JUSTIN GUINN; KATHERINE GRASHAM v. CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY, OKLAHOMA COUNTY DISTRICT CASE NUMBER CJ-2022-0036.

WHEREAS, the lawsuit styled *Justin Guinn; Katherine Grasham v. City of Oklahoma City* has been filed in the District Court for Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a settlement of Ninety-Five Thousand Dollars (\$95,000) and the requirement that Plaintiffs install a backflow preventer is a just and reasonable settlement of said case;


WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to make such settlement by authorizing the Municipal Counselor to draft the necessary paperwork to settle this case and to prepare and file a Journal Entry of Judgment, which does not admit liability in said case.
