

**SECOND EXTENSION OF COLLECTIVE BARGAINING  
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA  
CITY AND THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE,  
LODGE 123**

WHEREAS, the City of Oklahoma City, hereinafter referenced as the City, and the Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge 123, hereinafter referenced as FOP, have a collective bargaining agreement for fiscal year 2022-2023, which addresses the wages, hours, and working conditions of Oklahoma City employees represented by FOP. The 2022-2023 collective bargaining agreement operates through June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, on June 20, 2023, the City Council approved an extension of the 2022-2023 collective bargaining agreement to extend the terms and conditions of the 2022-2023 collective bargaining agreement until a successor contract is agreed upon for the 2023-2024, or until August 29, 2023, whichever occurs first (XI., Y.1., 2.); and

WHEREAS, representatives for management and labor have been negotiating for a collective bargaining agreement for fiscal year 2023-2024, but the parties have yet to reach a tentative agreement to recommend to the City Council and to the FOP membership; and

WHEREAS, the parties believe it to be in their best interest to further extend the 2022-2023 collective bargaining agreement as negotiations progress.

THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE to extend the terms and conditions of the 2022-2023 collective bargaining agreement until a successor contract is agreed upon for 2023-2024, or until September 29, 2023, whichever occurs first.
