Joint Resolution with the Oklahoma City Municipal Facilities Authority authorizing The City of Oklahoma City to accept a permanent easement and the Oklahoma City Municipal Facilities Authority to pay a claim in the amount of \$47,625 and authorizing the reimbursement of OCMFA funds by the general obligation bond program for Project PC-0557, street widening improvements, SW 15th Street from South Czech Hall Road to South Mustang Road. Ward 3.

Location:

SW 15th Street from South Czech Hall Road to South Mustang Road.

Background:

This 2017 General Obligation Bond Authorization, Proposition No. 1 - Streets, Bond No. B.8 provides for street widening improvements which may include related construction testing, inspection, project implementation and administration, planning, permitting, engineering and design, traffic control signals, signs, markings, devices, conduit improvements, street lighting, technology improvements, drainage, intersection improvements, sidewalk repair and installation, right-of-way acquisition, utility relocation, landscaping and related irrigation systems.

Final plans are expected by Summer 2022, with construction expected to start early 2023.
