Revocable Right-of-Way Use Permit with the OU Health Stephenson Cancer Center to hold the "Outpace Cancer Race," May 14, 2022, North Phillips Avenue between NE 8th Street and NE 10th Street, revenue of \$250. Ward 7.

Location:

North Phillips Avenue between NE 8th Street and NE 10th Street, University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center

Background:

The "Outpace Cancer Race" is an athletic event that includes both 5K and 10K runs and a 1-mile fun run. The event will be hosted by the University of Oklahoma's Stephenson Cancer Center and will aim to raise money for cancer research and to provide support for cancer patients and their families.

The staging area will be closed to all traffic providing a safe start-finish line. The courses will allow two-way traffic on a majority of the route. The curbside lanes on the affected streets will be closed exclusively for participants. University of Oklahoma Police Department Officers and OCPD officers will also provide traffic control during the event to keep participants and drivers safe.

Street closures for the staging area will be authorized from 6 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., allowing sufficient time for setup, teardown and cleanup of the event site. The street closures for the courses will be effective from 7:45 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.
