Revocable Permit with OKC Public Tennis LLC to hold the “OSSAA Girls and Boys State Tennis Tournaments,” May 6-7 and 13-14, 2022, Will Rogers Park, 3301 NW 32nd Street. Ward 2.

Background:

OKC Public Tennis LLC (Permittee) desires a Revocable Permit (Permit) to hold the “OSSAA Girls and Boys State Tennis Tournaments” (Event), as described above. Permittee will, at its expense, plan, organize, and manage the Event.

The Permit will be effective when approved by the City. It will authorize Permittee to use the Event site from 6:00 a.m. on Friday, May 6, 2022, until 11:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 7, 2022; and from 6:00 a.m. on Friday, May 13, 2022, until 11:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 14, 2022.

Permittee may regulate activities at the Event site. In addition, Permittee may limit vehicular access to the Event Site according to the Site Plan. The Permit also authorizes Permittee to change the flow of traffic along Pat Murphy Drive, during the Event, into a one-way street, flowing west to east.

Permittee must comply with applicable laws, rules, and regulations; provide insurance and indemnification; and protect City property within the Event site. This includes, but is not limited to, being financially responsible for damage from parking on grass areas within the Event site. In recognition on Permittee’s presentation and management of the Event, which benefits local and state-wide youth, Permittee will not be required to submit a Permit fee.
