Revocable Permit with the National MS Society for the “Walk MS Oklahoma City,” May 7, 2022, the South Oklahoma River Trail, revenue of \$1,300. Ward 6.

Location:

The South Oklahoma River Trail

Background:

The National MS Society (Permittee) desires a Revocable Permit (Permit) to hold the “Walk MS Oklahoma City” (Event), as described above. Permittee will, at its expense, plan, organize, and manage the Event.

The Permit will be effective when approved by the City. It will authorize Permittee to use the Event site from 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 7, 2022. Permittee must provide required insurance and indemnification; protect City and Oklahoma City Riverfront Redevelopment Authority (OCRRA) property; and comply with applicable laws, rules, and policies. OCRRA is scheduled to receive the Permit on April 26, 2022.
