Concurrence with the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust in approving Amendment No. 2 to Contract for Engineering Services with Garver, LLC, Project WC-0871, Atoka Pipeline raw water transmission line, Atoka Pump Station O to Coalgate, fee increase of \$102,680.

### **Location:**

Atoka Pump Station O to Coalgate

### **Background:**

The City of Oklahoma City owns, and the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust operates and maintains a 100-mile long, 60-inch raw water pipeline and six pump stations bringing water from the Atoka Reservoir in southeast Oklahoma to the Stanley Draper Reservoir in southeast Oklahoma City. A new 72-inch raw water pipeline will be constructed parallel to the existing pipeline.

Subsequent to execution of the original contract as previously amended and assigned, during review of the 35 percent plan submittal, it was determined that the original surveyed 100-foot easement and the actual location of the existing 60-inch pipeline within the easement and the alignment of the 72-inch pipeline needed to be adjusted in several areas of the project. As a result, the Design Engineer will be required to provide services beyond the original scope of work, including additional field verification of the existing pipeline alignment and revising the proposed 72-inch alignment.

The original contract must be amended to provide for the Design Engineer's increased scope of work as outlined above and associated fees.
