Bidding Information:

The City and Trusts have a need to purchase repair parts and services for non-highway and heavy construction equipment. The specifications were advertised in the Journal Record and posted in the electronic bidding system. Twenty-five potential bidders viewed the specifications with four bids submitted. Staff is recommending an award for the makes and brands bid by each vendor.

Departments are instructed to request price lists or portions thereof, for cost verification purposes, unless pricing can be verified through the vendor's website if submitted with their bid. Manufacturer's price lists may be updated during the term of the pricing agreement(s), however, the discounts and markups will remain firm. The contracted vendor(s) will be required to provide the City a copy of their insurance certificate if the need arises for on-site equipment repairs.

Staff requests open market authority for the purchase of original equipment manufacturers repair parts and services for non-highway and heavy construction equipment no bid items and related items not available on pricing agreements, estimated cost \$50,000, July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. Purchases made with this authority will comply with the City's open market purchasing procedures.

The estimated cost for these pricing agreements is based on previous expenditures for this commodity. The City is under no obligation to purchase from these agreements. All purchases are subject to future appropriations and the availability of funds.
