Renewal of Radio System License Agreement with the Oklahoma County Sheriff's Office to utilize the 800 MHz Trunked Radio System, estimated annual revenue of \$125,219, July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.

Background:

The City of Oklahoma City and the Oklahoma County Sheriff's Office entered into a Radio System License Agreement for the Oklahoma County Sheriff's Office to utilize the Trunked Radio System, for daily operation needs on July 17, 2018 (Item No. VII.AE.). The Radio System License Agreement allows the Oklahoma County Sheriff's Office and The City of Oklahoma City to renew the agreement annually for up to four additional years.

The agreement was renewed June 18, 2019 (Item No. VII.BJ.4.) for the period ending June 30, 2020, on June 16, 2020 (Item No. VII.AZ.7.) for the period ending June 30, 2021, and again on July 6, 2021 (Item No. IX.DX) for the period ending June 30, 2022.

The Oklahoma County Sheriff's Office indicated that they wish to renew the Radio License Agreement, subject to the same terms and conditions as originally approved on July 17, 2018.

Term:

July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023

Revenue:

\$125,219 annually for radio usage, maintenance, and capital replacement allocation fee to be deposited in the Information Technology Internal Service Fund – Other Services Charges (250-0460-42250008)
