Concurrence with the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust in approving Amendment No. 1 and Change Order No. 1, Project WT-0249-1, emergency Draper filter improvements, Draper Water Treatment Plant, increase of \$156,948.75. Ward 4.

**Location:**

Draper Water Treatment Plant

**Purpose:**

To match a quantity in the field and add contract time.

**Justification:**

It is necessary to adjust the expanding crack sealant in the floor slab and wall joints to resolve a leak issue.

**Background:**

The Draper Water Treatment Plant has 18 filters. Filter Nos. 9, 11, and 18 require immediate repair work to return them to service and meet current water demand. Inspection of the filters revealed significant cracking in the filter bottoms that required additional services to complete the repair work. The work will replace failed underdrains in Filter Nos. 9 and 18 and the media retention caps in Filter No. 11.
