Acceptance of a permanent easement, Project WC-0872, Atoka Pipeline raw water transmission line, Coalgate to Stonewall, Oklahoma.

Location:

Coalgate to Stonewall, Oklahoma

Purpose:

To provide right-of-way for water utility purposes and uses incidental thereto.

Background:

The City of Oklahoma City owns and the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust operates and maintains a 100-mile long, 60-inch concrete cylinder pipeline and six pump stations bringing water from the Atoka Reservoir in southeast Oklahoma to the Stanley Draper Reservoir in southeast Oklahoma City. A new 72-inch raw water pipeline will be constructed parallel to the existing pipeline. The portion containing the easement will contain approximately 15-miles of new 72-inch pipe to be constructed.

Claimant:

The Bureau of Indian Affairs was paid \$13,750 on September 4, 2019, for the permanent right-of-way easement.
