Resolution declaring 139 electric Club Car golf cars as surplus; and authorizing trade-in of the surplus equipment for the purchase of new equipment, estimated trade-in value \$173,750; and authorizing the purchase of 140 new 2023-2024 Club Car Tempo™ 48 Volt electric golf cars for the Lincoln Golf Course, from OMNIA Partners public sector purchasing cooperative (C230004), estimated cost \$967,106, total net cost after trade-in \$793,356.

Purpose:

To authorize the purchase of 140 new 2023-2024 Club Car Tempo™ 48 Volt electric golf cars from National Intergovernmental Purchasing Alliance Company, dba OMNIA Partners. The new golf cars will provide superior service over an extended life with the lowest cost of ownership. This provides the customer with a consistent expectation of comfort and reliability, while being the most responsible financial investment for the golf courses.

In November 2014, staff conducted research on the three major brands of golf cars and determined Club Car brand golf cars best met the needs of the golf courses. The golf courses intend to keep their fleets for at least seven to eight years and determined through references provided by the top three manufacturers that Club Car was the only manufacturer providing references beyond a five-year period. Golf course staff is also of the opinion that Club Car has taken steps beyond what the other manufacturers have taken to control battery acid run off which protects the electronics from unwanted moisture.

OMNIA Partners is a purchasing alliance available to government entities for the purpose of providing volume discounts for nationally bid contracts. Justice Golf Car Co., Inc. is providing a discount of 42% through the OMNIA Partners contract for this one-time purchase.
