Contract for Engineering Services with CEC Corporation, Project PC-0697, Roadway Widening, SW 149th Street between South May Avenue and South Pennsylvania Avenue, fee of \$429,363. Ward 5.

Location:

SW 149th Street between South May Avenue and South Pennsylvania Avenue

Background:

This 2017 General Obligation Bond Authorization project provides for roadway widening to at least a four-lane curb and gutter section with closed storm sewer, various drainage improvements and pedestrian sidewalk along one side of the project. Intersection improvements at SW 149th Street and May Avenue are to be included in the project.

The Preliminary Report is expected to be completed by early 2023.
