Revocable Right-of-Way Use Permit with Olde Capitol Hill Council Inc. to hold “Fiestas de las Americas,” October 1, 2022, SW 25th Street between South Robinson Avenue and South Walker Avenue, revenue of \$350. Wards 6 and 7.

Location:

SW 25th Street between South Robinson Avenue and South Walker Avenue, South Robinson Avenue from SW 11th Street south to SW 25th Street, Historic Capitol Hill

Background:

“Fiestas de las Americas” is a parade and community festival featuring music, food vendors, dance, family activities and a celebration of multi-cultural heritage.

This year the parade will use a brand-new route. The parade staging will be on SW 15th Street between Robinson Avenue and Walker Avenue and on Robinson Avenue from SW 11th Street south to SW 15th Street. The parade route travels south on Robinson Avenue and turns west onto SW 25th Street, passing through the festival area where the parade will then disband.

OCPD officers will handle the parade route and will keep participants, spectators and drivers safe.

The festival runs from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. and the parade will start at noon. The street closures for the festival would be effective from 3 p.m. on Friday to 11 p.m. on Saturday to allow sufficient time for setup, teardown and cleanup. The temporary closures for the parade would be effective from 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.
