Concurrence with the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust in adopting a Resolution ratifying the actions of the General Manager in declaring an emergency; ratifying the actions of the General Manager, or Designee, in awarding an engineering contract to Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc., Project SE-0047, emergency sanitary sewer improvements, Main Street to NW 6th Street and Western Avenue to Francis Avenue, \$350,840; and ratifying issuance of an emergency notice to proceed. Ward 6.

Location:

Main Street to NW 6th Street and Western Avenue to Francis Avenue

Purpose:

To ratify the actions of the General Manager in declaring an emergency and awarding an engineering contract.

Justification:

To expedite the design and construction of the sanitary sewer mains in this area. As such, a formal solicitation for the design services is not feasible.

Background:

The project will replace an existing 21-inch sanitary sewer line on Western Avenue, from south of Main Street to NW 6th Street, and an existing 10-inch sanitary sewer main from Western Avenue to Francis Avenue. The existing infrastructure cannot accommodate existing and planned sanitary sewer flows in the area and needs to be replaced.
