Concurrence with the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust in ratifying and approving Addenda Nos. 1 through 3; awarding a contract to Cimarron Construction Company, Project WC-1022, aerial waterline crossing replacement, NW 10th Street between County Line Road and the North Canadian River, \$1,147,741; and approving the contract and bonds. Wards 1 and 3.

Location:

NW 10th Street between County Line Road and the North Canadian River

Purpose:

To ratify and approve the addenda and award a construction contract.

Justification:

The addenda were required to modify the pre-qualification requirement, extend the bid opening date to November 2, 2022, update the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund documents and forms in the specifications, revise the line items, upload the minutes from the pre-bid meeting, update the plans, and answer questions from potential bidders. These addenda modifications take precedence over the original plans and specifications.

This project is to replace the existing aerial crossing that is leaking and currently shut down.
