First Amendment to the Emergency Solutions Grant COVID Program Agreement with Catholic Charities, to extend the contract period end date from June 30, 2022 to September 30, 2023.

Background:

The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), Public Law 116-136, was signed into law on March 27, 2020. On April 2, 2020, HUD informed the Planning Department that \$1,475,283 in ESG-CV funds had been allocated to the City. On June 9, 2020, HUD announced an additional allocation of \$5,928,669 in ESG-CV funds to the City. The CARES Act allowed these funds to cover or reimburse allowable costs incurred before the award of funding, including prior to the signing of the CARES Act.

On August 4, 2020, (Item VII.Q.), the City Council approved an Emergency Solutions Grant COVID Program Agreement with Catholic Charities to provide services in response to COVID-19. The initial funding amount of this project was \$171,955. The original term of the Agreement was through June 30, 2022.

On April 18, 2022, HUD issued Notice CPD-22-06, extending the expenditure deadline for ESG-CV funding to September 30, 2023.

The Amendment being submitted for approval today will extend the term of the Agreement through September 30, 2023.

\$171,955 from federal funds. City match is not required for this grant.
