Right-of-Way Agreement with Oklahoma Natural Gas Company for installation and maintenance of a natural gas pipeline serving northwest Oklahoma City, crossing portions of Will Rogers Park, 3400 NW 36th Street, revenue of \$72,370. Ward 2.

Location:

Crossing portions of Will Rogers Park, 3400 NW 36th Street

Background:

Oklahoma Natural Gas Company (ONG) requested the attached Right-of-Way Agreement (Agreement). It is needed to relocate a section of natural gas pipeline as described above. Previously, the pipeline was attached to a utilities bridge crossing Interstate 44 at Northwest 36th Street. However, the structure is being removed, and the pipeline must be relocated. ONG will bury the new pipeline, part of which will run underground through Will Rogers Park.

The Agreement allows ONG to use adjacent areas as temporary workspace during installation, maintenance, or repair of the new pipeline. However, ONG will coordinate those activities with staff and restore any areas damaged by such activities. Staff believe the designed route for the pipeline will minimally impact the park. ONG will pay the City \$72,370 for the Agreement. On November 16, 2022, the Park Commission recommended approval of the Agreement.

\$72,370 to be deposited in the General Fund – General Operations-UASN – Culture and Recreation - Parks-Facility Leases-Agreements (001-0001-REV1500-42050019)
