Plans and Project Manual submitted by C. H. Guernsey & Company for Project No. OCAT WRWA 2308, "Passenger Boarding Bridge Replacement - Phase I," and advertisement for bids.

Background:

On September 22, 2022, Trust authorized a Resolution utilizing the Contract for Professional Services with C. H. Guernsey & Company for Project No. OCAT GEN 2108, "Facilities Maintenance Engineering Services Agreement," to develop plans and specifications for "Passenger Boarding Bridge Replacement" at Will Rogers World Airport ("Airport"). The project's estimated construction cost is \$9,381,974.

Justification:

There are seventeen passenger boarding bridges at the Airport that are beyond their useful serviceable life. Replacement of the bridges will have to be done in phases. The six passenger boarding bridges that are in the worst condition will be replaced first. The Plans and Project Manual have been completed and are submitted for approval.

The award of the six passenger boarding bridges will be dependent on grant funding from the Federal Aviation Administration. All necessary funding beyond that provided through the Federal Aviation Administration's Airport Improvement Program will be Trust's responsibility.

Bids are scheduled to be opened on May 31, 2023.
