Resolution setting a public hearing September 26, 2023 for public comment regarding the consideration and approval of the assessment roll, Year 2023-2024, for the Downtown Business Improvement District, Oklahoma City Improvement and Special Services Assessment District No. 6, in the area commonly known as Downtown Oklahoma City, including Automobile Alley, Bricktown, the City Center, Deep Deuce, Midtown and West Village; and providing notice of said public hearing, as provided by law. Wards 6 and 7.

### **Location:**

In and around the area commonly known as Downtown Oklahoma City, including Automobile Alley, Bricktown, the City Center, Deep Deuce, Midtown and West Village.

### **Purpose:**

This request is for the continuation of the Downtown Business Improvement District (Downtown BID) for the fourth of 10 years to pay for services and improvements that include, without limitation, streetscape beautification, maintenance services, marketing, security, event management, economic development, special amenities maintenance such as the Underground Pedestrian Tunnel System and the Bricktown Canal, and sub-district specific services.

State statutes require an annual finding by the City Council that the Downtown BID should be continued and the filing of an updated assessment roll against each parcel of land to be assessed. Adoption of this resolution would set September 26, 2023 as the date for a public hearing and approval of the 2023-2024 assessment roll for the Downtown BID.

The third generation of the Downtown BID was established on August 18, 2020 (Item Nos. IX.J.1. and J.2.) for a 10-year period. The 2023-2024 assessment roll for the Downtown BID totals \$3,658,357.86
