Revocable Right-of-Way Use Permit with Aids Walk of Oklahoma City, Inc., to hold the “AIDS Walk of OKC,” October 1, 2023, West Sheridan Avenue between South Walker Avenue and Ron Norick Boulevard, revenue of \$100. Wards 6 and 7.

Location:

West Sheridan Avenue between South Walker Avenue and Ron Norick Boulevard, Myriad Botanical Gardens, Scissortail Park, Downtown

Background:

“AIDS Walk of OKC” is a community event featuring an afternoon 1-mile walk for participants. This year the walk will be held out of the Myriad Botanical Gardens. Participants will stage on the Devon Lawn prior to the walk. The walking route will take participants through Scissortail Park before returning to Myriad Gardens.

The walk route will be controlled by OCPD off-duty personnel. Additionally, organizers will work with OCPD and Embark to ensure that the streetcar will be able to operate safely through the event area.

The walk will begin at 12 noon. and the walking course closures would be effective from 2 p.m. to 3 p.m.
